Competition Guidelines

Eligibility

Applicants can be any student instrumentalist or vocalist (in grades 10-12 during the 2023-2024 school year and/or is at least 15 years old at the time of the performance) that meets any of the following criteria:

- Resides between Ponca City and Vinita (west to east) and Independence, KS and Skiatook (north to south).
- is a private student of a Bartlesville or Dewey private music teacher.
- is a private student or relative of a current BSO member.

Music Selection

Any concerto/aria/work (or movement) for solo instrument or voice that is 9 minutes or less for which orchestral accompaniment is available may be submitted for the audition. Selections must be approved by the BSO in advance of the audition. Use http://www.imslp.org as resources to help determine whether your piece is appropriate.

Memorization is strongly encouraged for both the audition and performance. It is the applicant's private instructor's responsibility to prepare the student for the intricacies of working with a professional orchestra for a concerto performance.

Audition

Applicants must perform with piano accompaniment for the audition and are expected to make their own arrangements to rehearse and perform with a pianist. Two pianos will be available at the audition site.

Applicants must supply 2 copies of the piano score for the judges, including at least one non-photocopied original.

Winner(s)

The winner(s) will be selected by a panel of judges. The winner(s) will each receive a \$500 scholarship award and be invited to perform with the BSO on their main stage concert on March 16, 2024. Each winner will also receive 4 tickets to the performance. The winner(s) may be asked to make appearances at other designated times and venues for marketing and/or educational outreach.

Fine Print

The judges reserve the right to select no winners if they determine that applicants do not meet the high standards of the competition. The Young Artists Competition committee reserves the right to cancel any of the winners' performances at any time over the course of the competition or performance with the BSO.
